Ski Bluewood to open on Friday, December 18

DAYTON, Wash.—Bluewood’s 2015-16 season begins this Friday, December 18, as the ski area welcomes skiers and snowboarders to the mountain.

“We’re stoked that opening day is almost here, and we can’t wait to welcome our guests and go out and have fun,” says Kim Clark, General Manager of Bluewood.

The Skyline Express and Platter Pull lifts are scheduled to run on opening day (Triple Nickel lift to be determined) with first chair at 9 a.m. Rentals, food services and snow sports also will be available.

Starting on December 18, Bluewood will be open every day through January 3 except for Christmas Day. Daily hours will be 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. except for December 24, which will be 9 a.m. to 2 p.m.

Bluewood news:

- **Lower prices on lift tickets.** Compared to last season, lift ticket prices have been cut by 18 percent to 22 percent. A full-day adult lift ticket is now \$39 (including tax), and a lift ticket for students, seniors and active military members is \$32. Children ages 6 and younger and seniors 70 and older ride free all year.
- **New Sno-Phone number.** Call (509) 240-8991 for daily updates about mountain conditions.
- **More days to ski and snowboard.** Typically open Thursdays through Sundays during January and February, Bluewood will also be welcoming guests on Wednesdays during these two months.
