Storm adds 16 inches to Bluewood's best snow in years

DAYTON, Wash.—Winter storms in the Cascades have been in the news, but here, closer to home, skiers and riders at Bluewood are enjoying the best snow in years.

"We've had such a blast in the awesome snow this year!" says Jeneé Franklin-Bush of Walla Walla, who skis at Bluewood with friends and 8-year-old daughter Maddaly. "There's been powder over our boots the days we've gone."

Bluewood has received a cumulative total of 270 inches (22.5 feet) of snow—and counting—this season. As of 1:22 this afternoon, it's still snowing with 80 inches at the lodge and 109 inches at the summit.

"With 16 inches of fresh snow in the last 48 hours and more in the forecast for this week, it doesn't get much better than this," says Kim Clark, general manager of Bluewood. "We're having a great season, and there's lots of excellent skiing and riding still to come."
