## Ski Bluewood opens Friday, December 22

*14 inches of new snow brings on the 2017-18 season*

DAYTON, Wash.—Bluewood’s 2017-18 season begins this Friday, December 22, as the winter sports area welcomes skiers and snowboarders to the mountain.

“We’re off to a bit slower start this year than anticipated due to snow conditions. But with 14 inches of fresh snow, and a total of 23 inches at the base and 30 inches at the summit, we’re ready to welcome everyone back to the mountain for great holiday skiing and snowboarding,” says Kim Clark, General Manager of Bluewood.

The Skyline Express and Platter Pull lifts are scheduled to run on opening day (Triple Nickel lift to be determined). Rentals, retail, food services and Snow Sports also will be available.

**Operating schedule:** Bluewood will be open daily from December 22 through and including January 1, except for Christmas Day (closed). Daily hours will be 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., except for December 24, which will be 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Starting in January, Bluewood will be open Wednesdays through Sundays every week and on Martin Luther King Jr. Day (Monday, January 15).
